

Directions to the Hubbard Brook Experimental Forest, Woodstock & West Thornton, New Hampshire

From Boston, MA / Manchester/Concord, NH areas (and other points south on I-93):

Proceed to I-93 and follow to the north (toll road). Take Exit #30. Turn RIGHT at the bottom of the ramp onto Route 3 South. Follow Route 3 about 2 miles to Mirror Lake Road on right (at Lily Pad Café). Turn RIGHT onto Mirror Lake Road. There is a small brown sign for Hubbard Brook here.

From Boston's Logan Airport: Proceed out of airport following signs to and enter ramp onto Rte. 1A/William F. McClellan Highway. Watch for signs and enter ramp to I-93 North. Stay on I-93 north all the way to Exit 30 in New Hampshire (see paragraph above). Travel time: About 2 hrs and 20 mins.

From Manchester, NH Airport: Exit airport and follow signs to I-93 North. Follow I-93 North all the way to Exit 30 in New Hampshire (see first paragraph, above). Travel time: About 1 hr and 20 mins.

From Upper Valley area: Take either I-91 to Fairlee (Exit 15), right off ramp, then left at stop sign onto Route 5 (North), go about ½ mile, turn right over iron bridge to NH. Go right on Route 10 (South) about ½ mile, turn left onto Route 25A. At Wentworth, road ends at a stop sign. Go right onto Route 25 toward Plymouth. At Plymouth, you will see signs for I-93 – go north on I-93 to Exit 30. Follow directions above.

(Alternative route from Upper Valley area: I-89 South to Enfield exit. Right off exit ramp onto Route 4 East. Go through Enfield. At Canaan, turn left onto Route 118. This road meets Route 25 at stop sign. Go right onto Route 25 toward Plymouth. Watch for I-93 North, proceed at Exit 30 as above).

Thence,

To Hubbard Brook Research Foundation's Mirror Lake Campus:

Follow Mirror Lake Rd about 8/10 mile, past public beach sign on right. Watch for road sign "Hamlet Drive." Turn right here, and follow about 100 yards to cottages.

To the Robert S. Pierce Laboratory at the U.S. Forest Service/Hubbard Brook Experimental Forest:

Follow Mirror Lake Road to the end where you will see the large reddish-brown Robert.S. Pierce Building. Parking is plentiful at the top of the hill behind the building. Most meetings take place here. The conference room is located just inside the main door to your right.
